This agreement is a binding contract when the school accepts it in writing. The registration fee is due when the student signs this agreement. The remaining tuition is due 14 days prior to first day of class. Prices for programs are as printed above. Books, supplies, and equipment are not included in any of the programs. The estimated cost of the required books, supplies, and equipment with tax is \_\_\_\_\_. There are no carrying charges, interest charges, or service charges connected or charged with any of these programs. Contracts are not sold to a third party at any time. Cost of credit is included in the price cost for the goods and services.

If a student is terminated or cancels for any reason, all refunds will be made according to the following refund schedule:

1. Cancellation must be made in person or by certified mail.
2. All monies will be refunded if the applicant is not accepted by the school or if the student cancels within three (3) days after signing the Enrollment Agreement and making initial payment.
3. Cancellation after the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) business day, but before the first class, will result in a refund of all monies paid, with the exception of the registration fee.
4. Cancellation after attendance has begun, but prior to 40% completion of the program, will result in a pro rata refund computed on the number of hours completed to the total program hours, with the exception of the registration fee.
5. Cancellation after completing 40% of the program will result in no refund.
6. Termination Date: The termination date for refund computation purposes is the last date of actual attendance by the student unless earlier written notice is received.
7. Refunds will be made within 30 business days from date of termination or receipt of Cancellation Notice.
8. A student can be dismissed, at the discretion of the Director, for insufficient progress, non-payment of costs, or failure to comply with rules.
9. A student can be dismissed or expelled if found in or on school property under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Mandatory drug testing is at the students expense and can be ongoing until graduation if allowed to resume. A student taking a prescribed narcotic or pain medication must provide a copy of the script to the director prior to entering school.

**RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION FOR THE RISK AGREEMENT**

The student hereby waives any claim against the school for injury suffered during or as a result of school activities including claims arising from any negligence or otherwise while participating in their course of study at Academy of Animal Arts Inc. This release does not include the willful or intentional misconduct of the Academy of Animal Arts Inc. The student assumes full responsibilities for the risk of bodily injury, death or property damage due to the negligence of the Academy of Animal Arts Inc. or otherwise during the course of the program. The student is responsible for medical bills or other costs if the student injures an animal during school activities or damages school property.

Prospective students that do not have evidence of a High School Diploma or GED will be required to sign an attestation document, students will also be required to take a fifteen question Ability to benefit test with a passing score of 80%. Prospective students under the age of 18 will be accepted with parental or guardian consent and are required to interview with the Director or Admissions personnel.

Upon successful completion of the program, the school will assist each qualifying graduate with job placement; however, the school does not guarantee employment. A Diploma will be issued to each student who successfully completes the program and satisfies all requirements. In the event of absence, the student will be charged for makeup work.
